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



Cactus has its own custom-built online reporting system. It allows you to pick and choose the information you need for your records.

A confidential login lets you check:

- Training objectives
- Trainee attendance record
- Dates of lessons scheduled and taken
- Progress report from the trainer
- Results of feedback forms and action taken
- Course outline and amendments
- Amount invoiced and paid to date

Trainees can use the same system to log in and pick up online language tasks and exercises if, for example, they are called overseas at short notice, or need to work from home.

External testing can be useful to assess and compare the language ability of job applicants or graduate trainees. However exam syllabuses are not geared to the specific language aims of tailor-made courses.

Cactus prefers to use more targeted measurements of success. These might include:

- An increase in sales which can be directly attributed to language ability
- Getting on better socially and culturally with people from other countries
- The achievement of a number of new sales leads, thanks to the language course
